Student Reading Records Report

The *Student Reading Records Report* presents data for every lesson a student has completed in the Reading component (SeeReader). Use the report to view important details pertaining to each lesson, and to view any relevant events connected to specific lessons.

View the date, time, and duration of a Reading lesson. Note that a Reading lesson typically takes 15 minutes to complete. View the content level associated with each lesson.

- The number indicates the readability level (3 = 3rd grade, 4 = 4th grade, etc.).
- Levels are presented to students as letters.
- "Hi" indicates high-interest, lower-readability content for secondary students.

View the title of each selection, and if the text was fiction or non-fiction. Click on any column header to sort the data.



View the rate at which the student read in the Guided Window (G-Rate). Once a student has attained her grade-level rate target, she will begin reading half of a selection in the independent format, without the Guided Window scaffold. At that point, independent rate (I-Rate) will be displayed.

View the number of optional ReReads the student utilized during the comprehension check.

- The ReRead allows the student to re-read the isolated portion of a text that addresses the comprehension question.
- By default, students can use up to two ReReads per lesson.

View the student's comprehension score on a lesson.

The Event column displays relevant events associated with specific lessons. In this example, you can see that the student's I-Rate was invalid for one lesson. In addition, the student Leveled Up upon completion of the selection titled "Einstein's Thought Experiments."
