

# Student Reading Records Report

The *Student Reading Records Report* presents data for every lesson a student has completed in the Reading component (SeeReader). Use the report to view important details pertaining to each lesson, and to view any relevant events connected to specific lessons.

- View the date, time, and duration of a Reading lesson. Note that a Reading lesson typically takes 15 minutes to complete.
- View the content level associated with each lesson.
  - The number indicates the readability level (3 = 3rd grade, 4 = 4th grade, etc.).
  - Levels are presented to students as letters.
  - "Hi" indicates high-interest, lower-readability content for secondary students.
- View the title of each selection, and if the text was fiction or non-fiction.
- Click on any column header to sort the data.

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- View the rate at which the student read in the Guided Window (G-Rate).
- Once a student has attained her grade-level rate target, she will begin reading half of a selection in the independent format, without the Guided Window scaffold. At that point, independent rate (I-Rate) will be displayed.
- View the number of optional ReReads the student utilized during the comprehension check.
  - The ReRead allows the student to re-read the isolated portion of a text that addresses the comprehension question.
  - By default, students can use up to two ReReads per lesson.
- View the student's comprehension score on a lesson.
- The Event column displays relevant events associated with specific lessons. In this example, you can see that the student's I-Rate was invalid for one lesson. In addition, the student Leveled Up upon completion of the selection titled "Einstein's Thought Experiments."
