

Site Reading Progress Report

Report Overview

The Site Reading Progress Report displays fluency and comprehension gains in the Reading component (SeeReader). The more lessons students complete, the better the results. For maximum benefits, most students should complete 100 Reading lessons or more each school year.

Callout 1: By default, data on the report is cumulative, including the current week of instruction.

Callout 2: Use the filter buttons to view data for specific time periods and/or subgroups of students.

Callout 3: View the average words-per-minute (wpm) reading rate gain for all students, along with the percentage of students who have attained grade-appropriate reading rates.

Callout 4: View the percentage of students currently reading content at or above grade level, as well as the percentage reading content just one level below grade.

Callout 5: View the number of students who have completed 1 - 20 Reading lessons, etc.

Callout 6: View average rate gains, based on Reading lessons completed. In this example, students who have completed between 61 - 80 Reading lessons have made average rate gains of 56 wpm.

Callout 7: View average grade-level gains, based on Reading lessons completed. In this example, students who have completed 61 - 80 Reading lessons have made average gains of 3.2 grade levels.



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View the number of students who have completed the initial assessment (InSight).

Note the number of students who have completed at least one Reading lesson during the defined time period.

View the average number of Reading lessons completed per student during the defined time period.

View individual students' average words-per-minute (wpm) rate gains.
