

Site Benchmark Report

Use the *Site Benchmark Report* to analyze growth over time based on InSight assessment results. Gauge growth by comparing average proficiency levels at different points of assessment, and consider the impact of Reading Plus use on proficiency-level increases.

By default, the report shows data for students who completed all selected benchmarks.

Click *Report Options* to filter data by a single benchmark, to compare benchmarks, see students who completed all selected benchmarks, and to display Text Lexile ranges for students' comprehension and proficiency levels.

Click *Proficiency Levels* to filter data by proficiency level for each completed benchmark.

Benchmark 1 (initial assessment) provides baseline data that is used to craft students' personalized learning paths.

Note: Students may also complete mid-year (Benchmark 2) and end-of-year (Benchmark 3) assessments.

Bar charts display proficiency levels relative to grade-level targets. For example: 'Below 3' is a proficiency level three grades below the student's current grade.

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View average comprehension level, vocabulary level, and comprehension-based silent reading rate for each administration of InSight.

Note the number of students who completed the initial (B1), midyear (B2), and/or end-of-year (B3) assessments.

- View the average Reading lessons completed per student at the time of each assessment.
- View total time spent in all instructional programs since the initial assessment (B1).

Note: *Students who diligently use Reading Plus typically see the greatest gains.*



Note that comprehension level and proficiency level can both be viewed as either grade-level measures (default view) or as Text Lexile Ranges. Click the *Report Options* filter button to view data as Text Lexile Ranges.

Click *Grades* or *Students* to see proficiency level increases by grade, or for individual students.

Proficiency level is a composite of reading comprehension level, vocabulary level, and silent reading rate.

Numbers in gray parentheses indicate gain when compared against the initial assessment (Benchmark 1).

Proficiency Group colors are representative of students at varying proficiency levels.

Proficiency Text Lexile presents the Text Lexile Range associated with a student's proficiency level.
