

# An Overview of your Teacher Dashboard

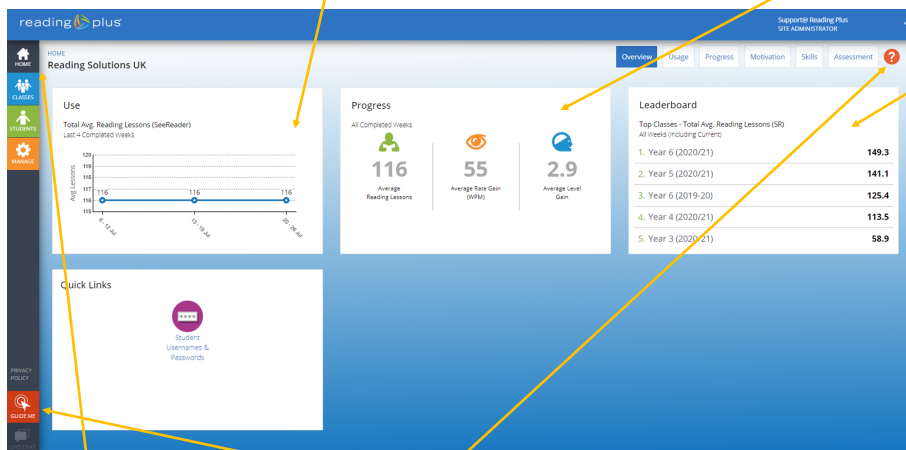
We would strongly recommend that you log in to your **Teacher Dashboard** whenever pupils are working on **Reading Plus®** as this will alert you to any pupils needing your immediate attention and allow you to monitor if weekly usage targets are being met.

When you first log in to Reading Plus, you are taken to the school's Home page. Your Home page gives you an overview of all usage and progress across the school. From the Home page, you can then access data for individual classes and pupils to monitor usage, progress and demonstrate impact.

## Navigating your Home page





For the Reading Plus Lead Teacher or a school leader, clicking on the **Use** tile brings up a report that lets you see an overview of usage across all classes on Reading Plus. Classes can be sub-divided into Pupil Premium, EAL, SEN, etc for monitoring.

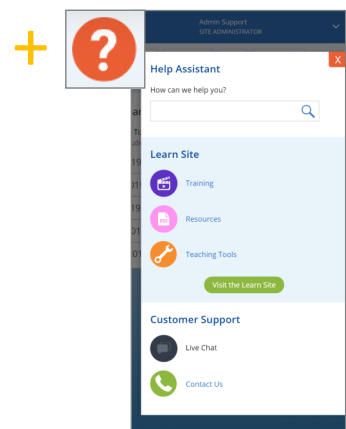
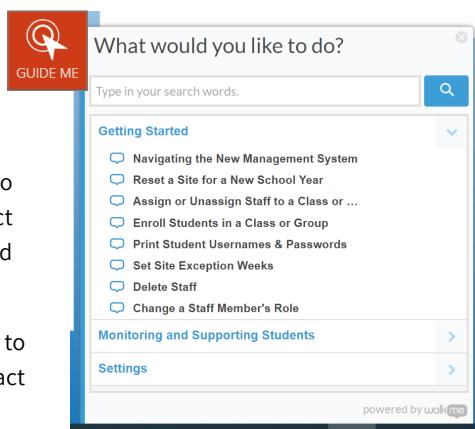
The **Progress** tile gives a Class by Class view of how many pupils are actively using the program, the number of Reading lessons completed, plus their gains in terms of average words per minute and comprehension level increases (months and years).



Click the **Leaderboard** tile for a downloadable report highlighting Class achievements (e.g. total words read, average comprehension score, numbers of Combos achieved this week).

You can print and display the Leaderboard report at the front of the classroom, or email to class teachers to share with pupils through an interactive whiteboard.

-  Choose the **Home** button to return to the Home page directly at any time
-  Choose the **Classes** button to access usage, progress & impact data on individual Classes and Groups (see p.2)
-  Choose the **Students** button to access usage, progress & impact data on individual pupils
-  Choose the **Manage** button to change settings and perform admin tasks (e.g adding/removing pupils).



The **Guide Me** button gives quick access to some of the most FAQs ...

... whilst the **Help Assist** button guides you to the **Reading Plus Learn Site** where you can access a comprehensive, easy to use bank of teaching resources and teaching tools.
