

## Terms and Conditions for Win Reading Plus - Festive Poem Competition 2024.

**By entering this competition, you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions:**

### 1. The Sponsor

The Sponsor of this competition is Reading Solutions UK, a company registered in England no. 09284598 ('the Sponsor'). This competition is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with, Facebook, X (Twitter), Instagram or any other Social Network.

### 2. Eligibility

The competition is closed to current licence holders of Reading Plus and schools subject to a free pilot of Reading Plus. The competition is open to schools in the United Kingdom. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.

### 3. The competition

To enter the competition, children/students must submit a poem themed '**Tales from the Snow**'. The poem can be acrostic, rhyming or non-rhyming, but must be no longer than 12 lines. If poems are entered by a parent, carer or guardian, they must have confirmation from the child's school that they would be willing to receive the prize if they win the competition.

### 4. The prize

**Three prizes will be awarded:**

**Prize (1)** - The school with the most votes will win a one-year subscription to Reading Plus (up to 35 licences), including full training, implementation and support for the duration of their licence.

**Prize (2)** - The school with the 2nd most votes will win a £200 Amazon voucher and a certificate.

**Prize (3)** - The school with the 3rd most votes will win a £150 Amazon voucher and a certificate.

No cash or other alternatives will be offered.

### 5. How to enter

Schools must register for the competition before they submit their entries. Poem entry submissions close at **midnight on 11th December 2024**.

**Only one entry per student will be accepted.** All entries must be received before the competition closes to be eligible. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.

### 6. Winner selection and notification

- The competition closes at midnight on Wednesday, 11th December 2024.
- Reading Solutions UK will shortlist six entries (poems).
- Shortlisted poems will be shared on Reading Solutions UK social media channels and a voting process will take place. Voting will take place between 16<sup>th</sup> December and 5<sup>th</sup> January.
- The top three entries (poems) that receive the most votes across all channels by midnight on Sunday, 5<sup>th</sup> January 2024 will be the prize winners.

Winners will be notified by email and shared on Instagram, X (Twitter), LinkedIn and Facebook.

**The winner of the 1st prize** (Win Reading Plus) will be contacted by their Regional Reading

Development Consultant, who will arrange a suitable time for training and provide instructions for onboarding up to 35 students onto the programme.

**The winners of the 2nd and 3rd prizes** will be sent the appropriate Amazon voucher for their position. No cash or other alternatives will be offered.

If selected as a winner, you will be required to provide the school's name, address and email address, and the headteacher or teacher's name. You will also need to provide the child's full name, age and year group.
